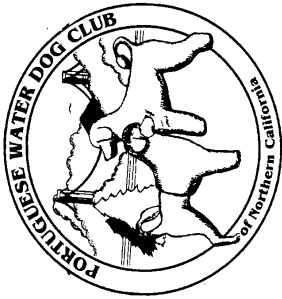

Hours - RV Overnight parking will be available: Thursday, July 11 – 4:00PM – 10:00PM; Friday, July 12 – 6:00 AM – 9:00 AM & 3:00PM – 10:00PM; Saturday, July 13 – 6:00AM – 7:00AM & after BIS – 10:00PM; Sunday, July 14 – 6:00AM – 7:00AM; All vehicles must be off the grounds by 8:00PM Sunday, July 14, 2013. Your parking space will be available in the afternoon of your arrival date, if you arrive earlier, you will pay for an additional night.

COST: \$90 per space for 2 nights. Two (2) night minimum. Additional night is \$45. **ONE NIGHT IS NOT AVAILABLE.** Spaces are 22' x 40'. Tagalong vehicles: \$20.00 flat fee - one, two or three nights, & must fit in your space, if not, they will be accommodated where possible. There will be no other accommodations for tagalong/tow vehicles in the RV overnight area unless it fits into your space. No vehicle traffic in RV areas during show hours.

No visitors can drive down to the RV area to drop off dogs, people, load, unload and/or visit. You must park in the day of show lot and walk.

Vehicles over 40' total length &/or with slide outs that will not fit in a 22' x 40' space will need to buy 2 spaces. If your entire package will not fit in a 22' x 40' space, you will need to buy additional space. Trailers & tow units may be required to be unhitched. Vehicles over 40' in length will be accommodated where possible. No more than 2 vehicles with a total length of 40' per space, this includes tag/tow vehicles.

NO ELECTRIC/POWER HOOK-UPS ARE AVAILABLE ANYWHERE ON THE GROUNDS - PLEASE BE PREPARED THAT YOU WILL NOT HAVE ELECTRICITY.

All RV's using a generator must have a proper exhaust pipe venting away from the dogs &/or people – Quiet time: 11:00 PM – 6:00 AM – No generators

RV OVERNIGHT PARKING COULD BE ON ASPHALT, CRUSHED ROCK, DIRT, WEEDS &/OR GRASS, BRING GROUND COVER. THERE IS NO GUARANTEE YOU WILL BE PARKED ON GRASS.

RV Spaces are PRE-ASSIGNED by RV Overnight Parking Coordinator. THOSE WISHING TO PARK TOGETHER MUST SEND THEIR RESERVATIONS TOGETHER, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.

Overnight parking may not be in the immediate vicinity of the rings.

Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective 1/1/2009) Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. Restricted to exhibitors who have not been a professional dog handler, judge, or employed by a professional handler at any time.

- **Veteran Classes** - Spayed/neutered allowed in veteran classes at independent specialties. Full registration required. Age determined as of day of show.
 - **Working Classes** - For any PWD holding a working title as issued by the Portuguese Water Dog Club of America, Inc. Note, a Junior Working Certificate is not a title. Dogs must be eligible to compete in AKC conformation in every way (must be intact and have full registration).
 - The winners of the above Veteran and Working classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

SPECIAL AWARDS

- **AWARD OF MERIT** - To be offered at Judge's discretion for not more than 10% of the entries in Best of Breed Competition, including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the winners of the the Veteran Dog & Bitch and Working Dog & Bitch classes.
- **BEST PUPPY** - Chosen from the first place winners of Puppy Dog 6-9, Puppy Dog 9-12, Puppy Bitch 6-9, and Puppy Bitch 9-12. If a Best Puppy entrant is chosen BOB or BOW, then it automatically is awarded Best Puppy.
- **BEST BRED-BY EXHIBITOR** - Chosen from the first place winners of BBE Dog and BBE Bitch. Must be handled by a breeder. If a Bred-By entrant is chosen BOB or BOW, it is automatically awarded Best BBE.
- **BEST VETERAN** - Chosen from the first place winners of Veteran Dog (7-10, 10+) and Veteran Bitch (7-10, 10+) classes.
- **BEST WORKING** - Chosen from the first place winners of Working Dog and Working Bitch classes.

- **Stud Dog Class** - For Dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this show. The Get is to be judged, not the Stud Dog. Stud Dog may be neutered. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and be shown in the ring with his Get. Get must be entered in a conformation class at this show.
 - **Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.
 - **Brace Class** - For two Portuguese Water Dogs similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs must have at least one common owner.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Important Notice to Exhibitors and Fanciers

California State policy prohibits the use of alcohol or tobacco products ANYTIME (24/7) or ANYWHERE on school property. Non-compliance may result in an Event Committee hearing.

We must each accept our responsibility for cleaning up after our dogs and leading the way for others to follow. Be prepared to dispose of any trash and/or leavings from your dog(s). Control your dog(s) at all times. **CLEANING UP IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!** Violators may be reported to the Bench Show Committee for disciplinary action. Have someone in your set-up area at all times.

Please **DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dog is seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Bench Show Committee for disciplinary action.

Notice To Exhibitors

- **AN AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.00 for each entry and a RECORDING FEE of 50 CENTS on first entry only** will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club show, obedience trial, or tracking test. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a show, the Recording fee is collected on first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chap 11, Sec 2)
- **A RALLY RECORDING FEE** of \$3.50 for first entry and \$3.00 each additional entry of a dog in the Rally Trial is included in the rally entry fee and will be paid to the American Kennel Club.
- **CONDITIONAL**, unsigned, incomplete, or telephoned entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees are not acceptable.
- **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink as entries will be photocopied. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries.
- **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **CHANGES**, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Telephone changes are unacceptable.
- **OWNERS OR THEIR AGENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS** on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete.
- **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted.
- **RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.** The Treasurer will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors or agent may result in their being put on a cash-only basis.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 6)
- **DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
- **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- **THE EVENT COMMITTEE WILL USE CARE** and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, nor assume the responsibility in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON:** A refund of ½ of Obedience and/or Rally entry fee will be offered to bitches that come in season after the closing date, with veterinarian letter and notice to Show Secretary at least 30 minutes PRIOR to the start of the trial.
- **CLASS TRANSFERS (MOVE-UPS)** are allowed in the Obedience and Rally Trials, provided there is space available in the class, and provided written notification is presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to judging.

Clean-Up Is Your Responsibility

Pooper-scoopers (in chlorine filled buckets) will be placed all around the grounds and outside all rings. If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or ring, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this show you are agreeing that all clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to an event committee hearing. Thank you for your cooperation.

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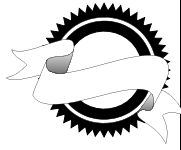
