Entry Limit

Friday: Limited to 15 dogs

Tent/RV Camping and Cabins at North Shore, Lake Camanche

We suggest you view campground map on next page and/or visit [Discover Lake Camanche](#) and scroll to North Shore to see all campground maps. We recommend Blue Oak Campground because there is running water, bathrooms and showers (bring quarters for showers!).

All accommodations below can be reserved by calling the North Shore Event Coordinator directly at 209-763-5121, ext 3211. Leave a message if he's not available and be sure to mention that you're with the Portuguese Water Dog Club.

- **Primitive Campground:** Private Tent or RV campsites at the trial site can be reserved for \$32.50/night, plus a one-time \$12 reservation fee. There is no running water or other amenities, other than porta potties. Driving and parking area is dry lakebed, surface alternates between hardpan, low vegetation and loose sand.
- **Blue Oak North Shore Campground:** Tent and RV campsites are just a few miles from the Primitive trial site. They vary in size and cost approximately \$9.50 to \$20.50 per night, plus a one-time \$12.00 reservation fee. While there are no electrical, water or sewer hookups for RVs (dry camping only), fresh water, shade sites, bathrooms & showers are available at Blue Oak campgrounds. Generators are allowed and a RV dump station located there.
- **Limited Tent Cabins (Blue Oak Campground) and Cottages (North Shore):** These accommodations fill up fast; ask to be put on a waiting list.
- **Outdoorsy or Air BNB** may offer condos, cottages or delivery of motorhomes to your pre-reserved RV site (no hookups on North Shore). Or you might be able to rent a dog-friendly cabin or condo in nearby towns such as Lockford, San Andreas, Jackson or Sutter Creek.

Directions to Lake Camanche's North Shore

From **Sacramento** go south on **Highway 99**. If you are headed to the North Shore, just south of **Galt** turn on **Liberty Road** and follow it east to **North Shore Parkway**.

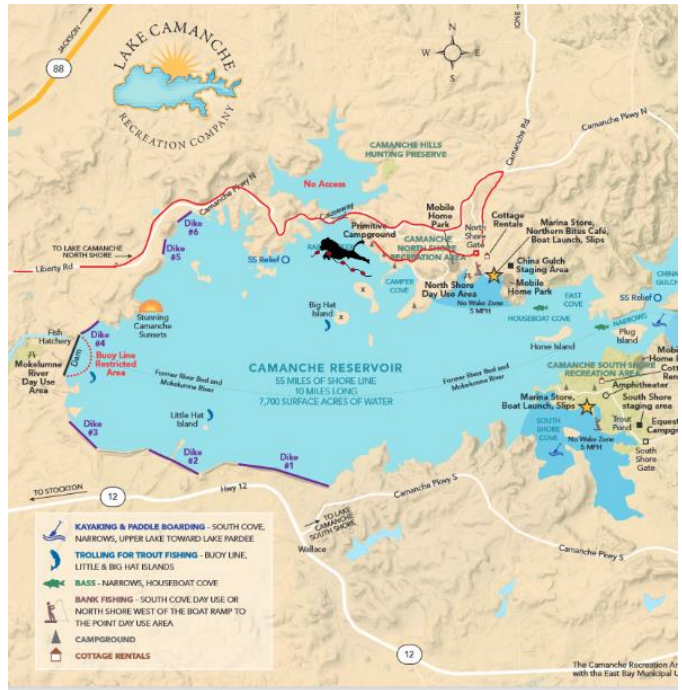
From **Stockton, Lodi**, or anywhere else to the south, follow Highway 99 to Lodi and then go east on Highway 88/Waterloo Rd. At the Highway 88 and Highway 12 junction, continue on 88 North toward Jackson. Turn right (east) on Liberty Road (which turns into Camanche Parkway North). Liberty Rd to the park entrance is approximately 7.4 miles, where you'll see a park sign on your right. Turn right onto Camanche Rd and proceed to the park gate.



Check in at the North Shore Park Gate (be sure to tell them you're with the Portuguese Water Dog Club of), and then proceed to Primitive Campground.

Notice to All Participants

Trial Site Overview: Our water trial site is located on a fairly flat, dry lakebed whose surface alternates between hardpan, loose sand and low vegetation. You will approach on paved roads and transition to dirt and sand to arrive at the actual trial site. There are no shade trees at the trial site, so please bring a shade structure for you and your dog(s). There is no running water at this site. Running water is available at Blue Oak Campsite.

Security: Limited security at trial site provided by the Park. Leave your setups at your own risk.

Parking: Park entry/parking fees are normally \$10.50 per day (off season rate) if you do not reserve accommodations at the park.

Site Rules and Conditions: No dogs allowed off leash except for dog being tested. Dogs must be on leash or confined to crates at all times except when participating in a warm-up session in the trial ring or being judged. Participants are responsible for picking up after their dogs.

Equipment: Participants may use their own equipment if approved after inspection by the judge or designee. Additional or substitute equipment will be provided by the PWDCNC.

Mandatory - PFD and Footwear: Any person working a dog in or near the water and any substitute steward must wear closed-toe footwear and a USCG-approved life vest.

What to Bring: Extra water for you and your dog, crate, USCG-approved life vest, closed-toe footwear, towels, foul weather gear, trial equipment, leash, water dish, dog food, poop scoop, bags, etc. Shade structures and chairs are necessary as there is no seating or natural shade close to the trial site.

Age minimums: A dog must be at least six months of age on the day of the trial to enter the Junior Water Dog level and one year of age to enter the Apprentice level and above, unless the dog has successfully passed the Junior level. Handlers must be 9 years old.

Rules and Regulations: The trial will be held in accordance with the most current provisions as set by the PWDC Water Trial Manual and addendum. Each participant is responsible for familiarizing themselves with said regulations. Copies of the Water Trial Manual may be downloaded from [PWDC Water Manual](#)

Eligibility: A dog must be at least six months of age on the day of the trial to enter the Junior Water Dog level and one year of age to enter the Apprentice level and above, unless the dog has successfully passed the Junior level. Minimum age of handlers and substitute stewards: 9 years. A Junior Water Dog certificate is not required to enter the Apprentice Water Dog test unless the dog is under 12 months old. A dog must have an Apprentice Water Dog title to enter the Working Water Dog test, a Working Water Dog title in order to enter the Courier Water Dog test and a Courier Water Dog Excellent title to enter Master. A dog may be entered and exhibited only once, at one test level, at the Water Trial.

Both regular and non-regular entries will be accepted for the Water Trial. Both may qualify and receive awards. A regular entry is any entry in Master Water Dog or any other test level where the dog has not earned a title/certificate before September 8, 2021. This includes a level where a dog earns a title/certificate on or after September 8, 2021 so long as the dog is not shown at a higher level before the Trial. A dog may be a non-regular entry only at the level of the highest title it has earned at any time before the Water Trial. **AN OWNER OR HANDLER MUST NOTIFY THE TRIAL SECRETARY IF A DOG EARNS A WATER TITLE OR CERTIFICATE AFTER THE DOG HAS BEEN ENTERED IN THIS WATER TRIAL.**

Acceptance of Entries: The club has the right to refuse this entry or any entry for any cause which they deem to be sufficient.

Move-ups: Eligible dogs may be moved up to a higher test level if the trial secretary has received a written request at any time before 6:00 p.m. (PDT) on Tuesday, September 21, 2021. Email requests are acceptable. However, for inclusion in the catalog, move-ups must be received no later than the closing date, September 21, 2021.

Move-ups for Sunday: After passing on Friday or Saturday, move-ups for Sunday will be considered at the discretion of the judge and the water trial committee as long as judging time does not exceed 8 hours and 35 dogs per day. Move-ups will work after the last regularly scheduled dog in the class.

Substitute Stewards: A participant may use his/her own steward and the substitute steward must be named on the entry form. Requests for any change in steward must be approved by the Trial Secretary and Judge. Substitute stewards must conduct themselves according to the PWDC Water Trial Rules and Regulations. **Should a substitute steward not be named on entry form, a club steward will be assigned. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Closing Date: Mail-in entries will not be accepted unless they include the Participation Agreement on the entry form, are properly completed and signed, and include the appropriate fee. Online entries will not be accepted unless they are properly completed, and the appropriate fee has been paid. **ACCEPTABLE ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE CLOSING DATE, 6:00 p.m. (PDT) on September 21, 2021.** After this time entries may not be accepted, cancelled or substituted. Entries may NOT be hand delivered, faxed, or telephoned. If using Express Mail or courier service, "no signature required" for delivery must be specified.

Refunds: Entries may be cancelled or changed online prior to close of entry, with refunds (less the \$3.00 Processing Fee per entry) available to keep as PerfDog credit, refund to credit card, or mail via check (less an additional \$3 Check Fee). Entry fees shall not be refunded after closing date, in the event the dog is absent, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts of God beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

COVID Rules for entering these trials: DO NOT COME IF YOU FEEL SICK!!! (In this situation, if the club is able to fill your entries from the waitlist, your entry fees will be refunded.) **COVID 19 Best**

Practices: 1. Participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that are in effect at the time of the event. 2. You may be required to wear a mask while outside your car if so required at the time of the trial. You may be required to wear a mask if so required by the county, state or federal requirements while competing with your dog. You must bring your own mask!

Order of Judging and Judging Program: The order of judging will be determined by a random drawing on or about September 24, 2021. We encourage you to enter early. A judging program containing the order of judging of teams will be emailed to each entrant with the final entry confirmation.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season will be exhibited at the end of the day. The owner or handler of such a bitch must notify the trial secretary of the bitch's condition before the start of the trial. Bitches in season shall not be brought to the test area or the surrounding area until their handlers are instructed to do so by a judge or judge's designee.

Awards: Dogs which successfully pass all exercises required in their test level will receive a rosette and the applicable certificate or title from the PWDC, Inc.

Rights: All rights to televise, tape, advertise, photograph, promote, or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the host clubs or their assignees. By attending the event, all persons in attendance grant permission (without need of any further consent) for the use of their and their animals' likenesses and voices in any resultant product.

Senior Water Dog Challenge

Do you have a senior (age 8 years or older) PWD that loves to work in the water but is now retired from water competition? Well, the 2021 PWDCNC Water Trial has the perfect event!

PRIZES will be given to all pre-registered entrants. We anticipate being able to accommodate 10 teams. Preferred entry will be given to oldest dogs first then descending order of age. As there is no title or certificate involved there will be a volunteer judge in the ring to direct the team to perform the exercises but there will be no scoring. The only goal is to have FUN with your dog!

Senior Challenge Rules

Do you have a senior PWD that loves to work in the water but is now unable to compete? Then the PWDCNC Specialty Senior Water Dog Challenge the perfect event for the two of you!

The challenge consists of four exercises that are based on the traditional PWDCA Water Trial exercises that have been modified to accommodate older dogs that may not have the jumping ability nor the stamina of their younger years.

The exercises are as follows and there will be a 1 minute warm up allotted for each entry:

1. **Dummy throw** – dog and handler stand behind the 3' line, dog is at the handler's side, under control. Handler may not hold onto dog at this time. At the judge's direction, the handler throws dummy 35-50' into water. Upon judge's direction, the handler sends dog to retrieve dummy. Dog delivers dummy to the handler's hand after crossing the 3' line. The dog/handler have 2 minutes to complete the exercise.
2. **Underwater retrieve** – (same as AWD exercise) - The handler and dog enter the water to a depth of water that will allow the dog to complete the task as required. The dog must be at the handler's side (either side), facing the same direction as the handler. Dog and handler will be parallel to shore. The area from the dog's head to the dog's shoulder shall be approximately in line with the handler's hip. On the judge's signal, the handler drops the object in the water at arms length in front of the dog and parallel to shore. The object must sink immediately. As soon as the object sinks, and without further direction from the judge, the handler sends the dog and the dog retrieves the object and delivers it to hand above the surface of the water. The dog/handler have 1 minute to complete the exercise.
3. **Gear Bag retrieve** –(same as WWD exercise) - On the judge's signal the steward will, in full view of the handler, quietly place the gear bag on land 25' feet away from the team, and move out of the immediate area. On the judge's signal, the handler will send the dog to retrieve the gear bag. The dog may pull or carry the bag, but must deliver it to the handler's hand. The exercise ends with the delivery of the gear bag. The dog/handler have 1 minute to complete the exercise. The dog should be alongside the handler, under control before being sent to retrieve the gear bag. The dog does not need to sit. The gear bag may contain items or be empty.
4. **Double Directed Retrieve** – Dog and handler remain on the shore while the steward boat rows out to the 50' line in the center of the two markers with the two dummies. Upon the judge's direction, the steward in the boat will throw the dummies in the order decided by the judge. The dummies will be thrown towards shore approximately halfway between the marker and the shoreline. Upon the judge's direction, the handler will send the dog to the first dummy. The handler may then wade out to take delivery of the first dummy at the dog's swimming depth. Once the first dummy is received to hand, the handler will send the dog to the second dummy. The handler may stay in the water or return to shore to receive the second dummy to hand. The exercise is complete once the second dummy is delivered to hand. The dog/handler have 3 minutes to complete the exercise.

Disclaimers

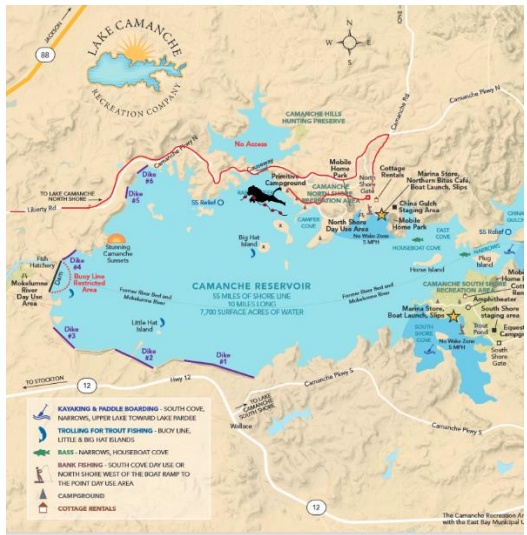
- This is not a titling nor certificate event for the PWDCA.
- This event is for all Senior PWD's that are unable to compete with the traditional exercises in PWDCA water work. Dogs entered in this event may NOT be entered in the sanctioned water trial.
- The usual equipment regulations will apply (gear, lifejacket, closed toe shoes, dog harness). Dogs may wear a floatation device.
- Senior PWDs must be 8 years of age or older. All dogs and their handlers should be prepared to have FUN and enjoy some time together in the water!

I/we understand that the dogs must be in good health, proper fitness and condition for the test they are about to enter and must be at least 6 months of age in order to compete in the water trials. I/we agree to these terms. I/we accept full responsibility for the care of my dog(s) during the water trial.

Special Rules: The water trial is located within the confines of _____.
I/we agree to become familiar with and adhere to all site rules and regulations including but not limited to the following:

- Dogs must be on leash or confined to a crate at all times except when participating in practice sessions or when actually being judged.
- If my dog soils the grounds, I am responsible for cleanup and disposal
- Nothing (dogs, banners, etc.) is to be attached to any tree in the park.

Hold-harmless: I/we agree to hold the PWDCA and the event-giving club, their members, directors, officers, agents, and judge(s) at this event, the owner and/or lessor of the premises, any provider of services for this event and any employees or volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss, injury, or illness which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person, animal or thing by the act of my dog while in or upon the trial grounds or while entering or leaving same, and I/we further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, disappearance or theft of, or damage injury or illness to, my dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury or illness is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any other parties aforementioned, by the negligence of any other person, or by any other cause or causes.
