Awards: Each dog passing FCAT will be offered a light blue ribbon. Dog must cross the finish line. Rosettes will be offered for dogs earning the BCAT, DCAT and FCAT titles if the title is earned at these events. Boston Terriers Only: High Score 1st—3rd in each event.

Two separate tests are offered each day. Tests will run concurrently. Dogs will run back-to-back. You may use a single-entry form per dog to enter one or all the tests by circling the information on the entry form. Each test requires a \$25 entry fee for pre-entered dogs. Late entries and day of entries \$30 per run. Conditional entries will not be accepted.

Day of entries will be accepted at 11:00 am each day. All day of entries will run in the last group each day.

Dogs will run in groups of 30. Both Tests for each dog will occur in the same group/time slot. Once entries have closed exhibitors will be notified of their group and approximate start time. Check in will be 10 minutes before the approximate start of each group.

Trial Hours: One hour prior to the published start time through one half hour after completion of judging. First Dog will run at 9:00 am

Be sure your dog can be caught at the end of the course.

A dog may enter only once per test—defined by an event number.

The Test Committee reserves the right to bar dogs that are known to be aggressive. The Test Committee reserves the right to alter the track as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test. No refunds if the track is altered due to weather and/or field conditions.

A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose dog not competing while the test is in progress.

Bitches in season, or bitches which come in season after the close of entries, shall be barred from participating in the test or trial and their entry fees refunded. Notification to the Field Secretary of bitches in in season must be made before or during the roll call. Bitches known to be in season shall not be brought near the FCAT Track.

Release of Liability, Expressed Assumption of Risk, Hold Harmless

By signing the entry form for this event and participating in the event I agree to these additional conditions: I understand that there are risks associated with my/my dog participating in FCAT. These injuries or outcomes may arise from my own or other's actions, inactions, or negligence.

Nonetheless, I assume all risks of my participation in FCAT and release from liability and waive my right to sue the Club, Facility, Show Secretary, Lure Owner, Lure Operator, and any other person involved with the event.

Food and Beverages: Lunch will be provided for Judge, Show Committee and designated full time workers. All others should plan to bring your own meals, snacks and beverages. No food or beverage purchase available onsite.

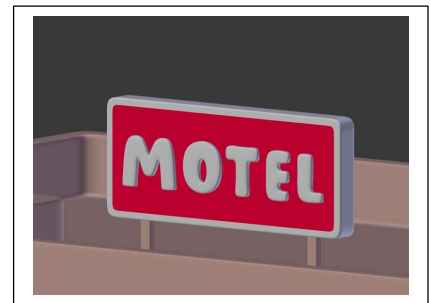

Notice to Exhibitors

- The FCAT Test is open to all dogs at least twelve (12) months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with the foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and spayed/neutered dogs are eligible to participate.
- FCAT Groups will be determined by random draw.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of reason, there will be NO refund of entry fee.
- All refunds will be sent, by check, seven days after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by Action of the Trial Committee
- No entry fee will refunded if the trial cannot be open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, weather, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Organizing Committee
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry form. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be accepted or entered in the event.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made. This includes Entry Fees and RV Fees
- All dogs must always be on leash except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Events
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The Club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine is required in the State of California

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.
